With Cooke's support, Fisher called together in Kansas City on November 1, 1940 the first national convention of managers of municipal utilities. These managers met for the purpose to organize the National Association of Municipal Utilities, which Foster had proposed to create in 1933 in connection with national recovery efforts. Foster had served as the first president of the organization.

Government had an impressive reputation as a supporter of public power. In 1941 he headed off efforts to put Los Angeles out of the power business by persuading business interests that a monopoly by Southern California Edison Co. would result in higher rates and more inefficient service. He also was a major supporter of the construction of Boulder Dam (later renamed Hoover Dam), and his advice was actively sought on public power issues by the federal government and others.

Subsequent work led to studies preparing to Boulder Dam and other issues affecting the long-term use of Los Angeles, and this program was made to serve the National Association of Municipal Utilities at the Kansas City meeting. The central office was established and an office was organized.

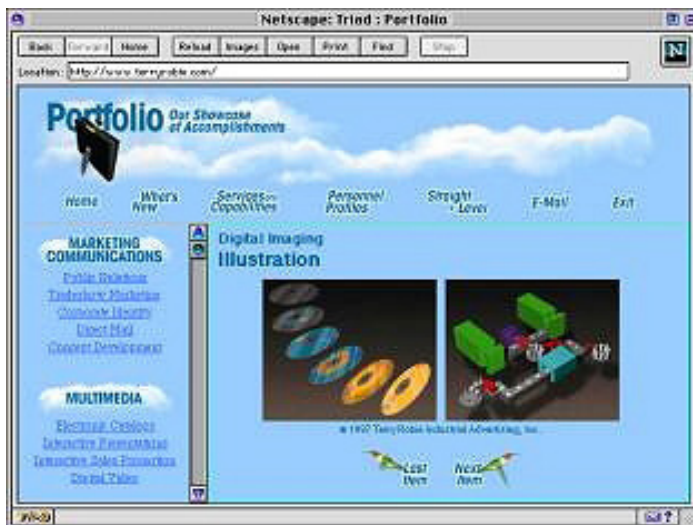

The owners of TRIAD were aviation enthusiasts and amateur pilots. This aviation motif seemed perfect when the company's website was built in 1997.



I used Specular Infini-D to create the short looped 3D GIF animations that represented each section of the site. I drew the clouds by hand in Photoshop.



One of the owners suggested banner ads that weren't actually ads, they were called "squawks," a colloquial aviation term for an aircraft's self-identifying radio burst. The content of these "squawks" included jokes and facts.

The site was alive with animation. Exit pages are rarely seen on today's



internet, but in 1997, this exit page featured a skydiver that floated downscreen while geese flew across the header.
